

## GRADUATE STUDENTS

Permits and enforcement use License Plate Recognition (LPR), with parking permits tied to your license plate. Please note your license plate before you begin your transaction. **Only one vehicle may be registered on your account at a time.**

While completing your transaction, we strongly encourage you to sign up for parking-related texts, such as reminders about construction closures and athletic events.

## ANNUAL PERMIT OPTIONS

Please review the information about each specific type of permit carefully before attempting to purchase your parking permit. Payment must be the fee added to your tuition account at Student Account Services. Charges will appear on accounts on the following business day.

Graduate students are eligible for the following types of permits:

Type	Annual Price	Description
Park & Ride	\$203	Valid in lot 301 only. Connect to Jayhawk Boulevard and points in between using route 41.
STAFF Yellow	\$302	We are pleased to offer graduate students the "staff" yellow permits this year, which will allow year-round universal access to all yellow zones, AND access to lots marked "staff only" after 5 p.m.
University Housing	\$306	For students living in residence halls, specific to each area.
Mississippi Street Garage Only	\$306	For students living in scholarship halls. Valid in garage only, not yellow or AP zones. Must vacate garage for home football games. Annual only.
Mississippi Street Garage Yellow	\$323	For students living off campus. Permits limited, with waiting list once permits are sold out. No preference given to renewals
Allen Fieldhouse Garage Yellow	\$323	Renewals only. Limited to returning permit holders and graduate students on waiting list.
Central District Garage Yellow	\$323	For students living off campus. Permits limited, with waiting list once permits are sold out. No preference given to renewals.
Carpool	Variable	Two or more students may form a carpool. Application must be made in person, and will be available July 16. Valid in lots 52 and 61. Price
Cycle Red / Moped WITHOUT PURCHASE OF A CAR PERMIT	\$87	For students with motorcycles. Valid in all red motorcycle or student moped zones, including motorcycle and moped zones inside parking garages. Not valid in bike racks. Does not grant access to Jayhawk Boulevard.  <b>Not for sale online in the portal, please use the <a href="#">online order form</a>.</b>
Cycle Red / Moped WITH PURCHASE OF A CAR PERMIT	\$29 *	For students with motorcycles. Valid in all red motorcycle or student moped zones, including motorcycle and moped zones inside parking garages. Not valid in bike racks. Does not grant access to Jayhawk Boulevard.  * - TO QUALIFY FOR THE \$29.00 RATE, THE CAR PERMIT MUST BE PURCHASED FIRST, MUST BE PURCHASED FOR THE FULL YEAR, AND THE CAR PERMIT CANNOT BE RETURNED.  <b>Not for sale online in the portal, please use the <a href="#">online order form</a>.</b>
STAFF Red Permit (for Grad Students)	\$351	For one year only, grad students are eligible to purchase a universal red zone permit. Valid in all red, yellow, housing, and park and ride lots.

## SHORTER-TERM OPTIONS

You may find you're on campus less due to virtual classes this fall, so we are introducing short-term options that will allow you to periodically park on campus, as needed.

- **30-use and 15-use permits**
  - Permits are valid for the number of stated uses. Parking on any given day constitutes one use.
  - Available in Park & Ride, Yellow, and Red.
  - Permits are not date-specific.
  - Each unique date that a registered plate is scanned by a mobile LPR (license plate recognition) vehicle constitutes a single use, even if that scan results in a ticket. (e.g., If you paid for a Yellow permit and park in a Red lot, that counts as a single day use and you would be ticketed for parking in the incorrect lot).
  - KU Parking will send you an email showing your declining balance of uses on the permit.
  - Permits expire July 31, 2021.
  - No refunds for unused days.
  
- **Daily permits**
  - Daily permits can be purchased online through the KU Parking portal.
  - Available in Park & Ride, Yellow, Red, and parking garages (qualifications restrictions apply).
  - Dates must be specified.
  - A maximum of five days can be purchased at a time.

- No limit on number of purchases.
- No refunds on purchases.
- Not available on payroll deduction.

If you're not sure what type of permit you'll need to start, you can start the year with a short-term permit or multiple short-term permits, and purchase an annual permit later, if needed. Be sure to use all days of your short-term permit before purchasing an annual permit. Annual permits can be purchased at any time and will begin prorating weekly on Sept. 6.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Permits will be on sale **ONLINE ONLY**. In order to purchase your permit:

1. Go to <https://ku.nupark.com/portal/> and click on "University of Kansas" button to log in.
2. Once you are logged into MyKU, you will automatically be redirected back to the parking portal to begin the purchase process.
3. If you have outstanding parking fines, you will not be allowed to purchase a permit. You must first pay outstanding fines with a credit/debit card in the same website, but not in the same transaction.
4. Answer questions and select permit.
5. If you are purchasing both car and motorcycle permits, you will have to do this in two separate transactions. Please see table above for information about the discounted rate for cycle permits when purchased with a car permit.
6. You will be asked about your **vehicle information**, which is **required** to complete your transaction.
7. Payment option: "Bill My Student Account" is the only option, to facilitate potential refunds later.
8. Remember to sign up for parking-related text messages!
